Treasurer's Report: \$584.12 balance.

Income: Projected dues for 2012 are \$540.00 added to our existing balance of \$584.12 gives us a projected balance of \$1124.12. The timer will cost \$750.00 and CMSA dues/insurance will be \$425.00. This will make us a little short. After the timer is purchased we will start charging \$10.00 for a run down. If you supply your own balloons and ammo it will be \$4.00; \$2.00 for the club and \$2.00 for the pot. A drawing at the end of practice will determine the winner of the pot.

Practice: We will continue our practices on the first and third Saturday of each month. Brenda suggested a fall/winter start time of 12:00.

Positions Needed: Match Director is needs that must be familiar with the CMSA rules and work closely with the Range Master. Most of the work will be done getting ready and during a match. This person could be a competitor but this is not a requirement. Board of Directors is needed to settle disputes during a match and write by-laws for the club. This would be approximately 5 people. Fund Raiser Committee, are needed to help us support the club. Really creative people need to step forward for this one! Substitute Range Master, is needed so that our Range Master, John can compete. You must be able to pass a test. The test costs \$20.00 and will be paid for by the club.

Profile Forms: These are on-line and need to be printed out and filled out by each member. Please return it with a copy of your Coggins and October 2012 dues. During a match the announcer will use these to tell the audience a little about the rider and horse; it will also give us a place to list our Coggins.

Dues: No changes from the Executive Meeting Notes.

Advertizing: We need to announce locally our practices and future matches.

Holsters: Several members went south of Bowling Green to an Amish gentleman that makes rigs. Stanley will share directions with anyone that wants to go there.
